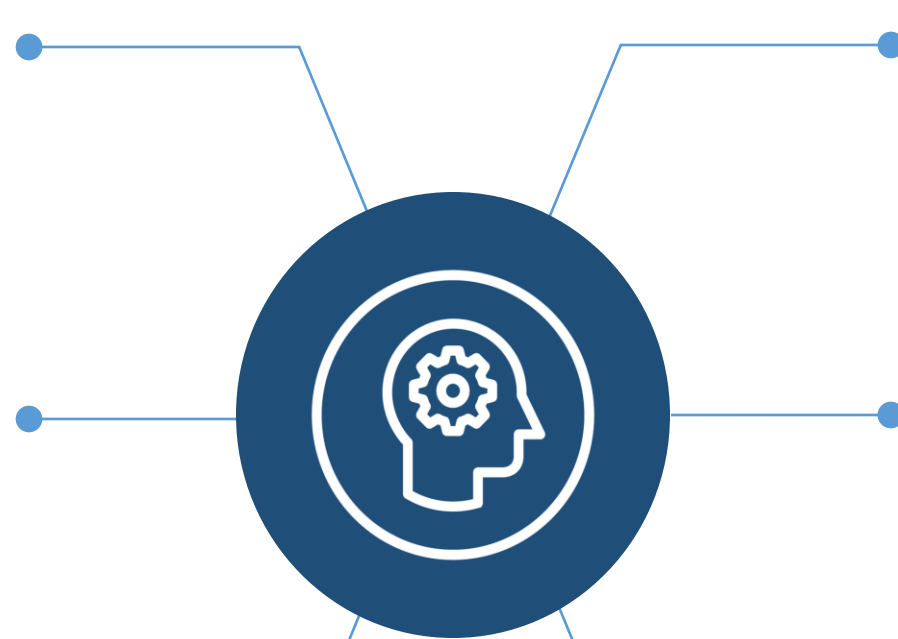

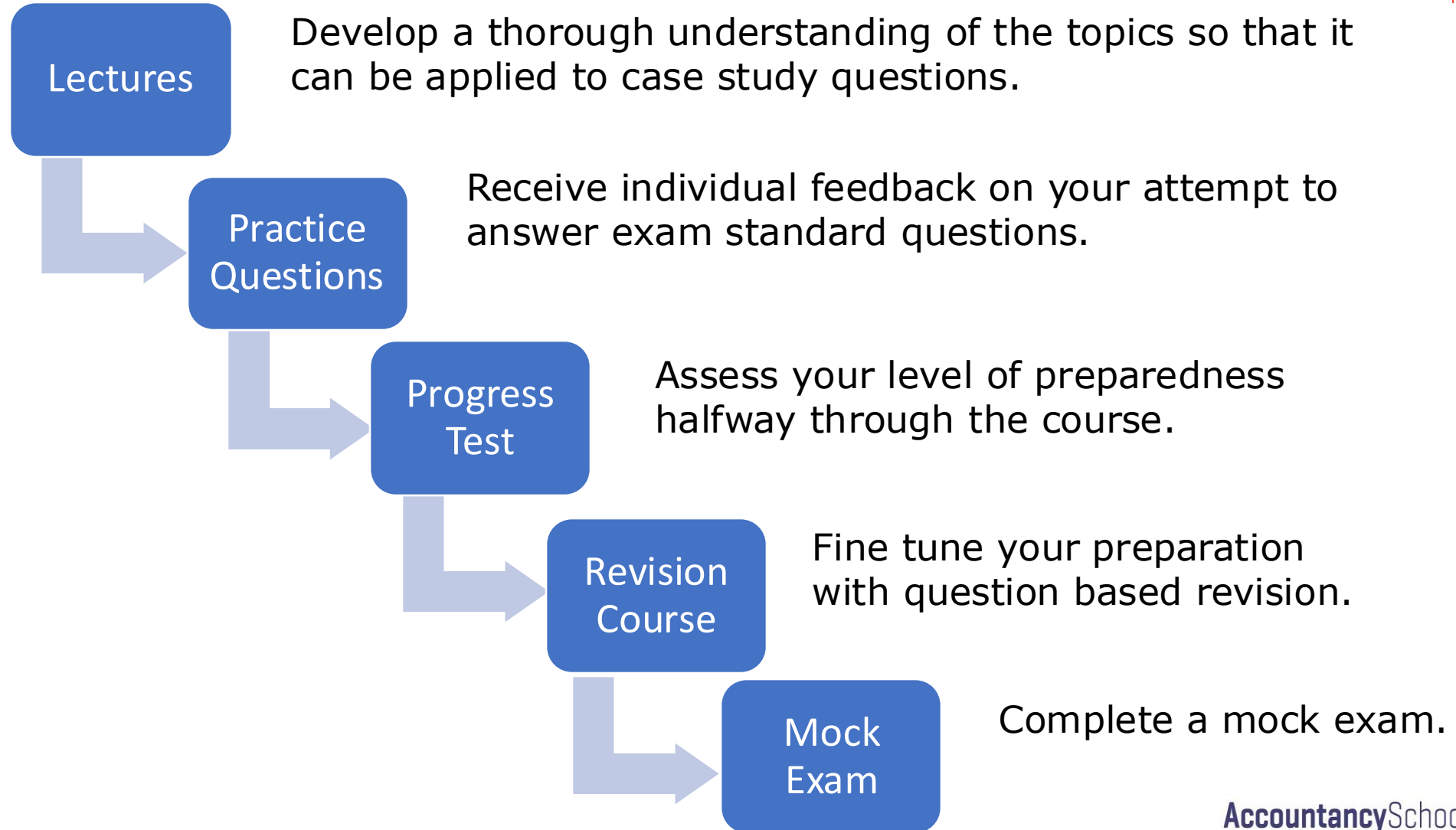

On-demand CBE First 4 Papers namely the 3 Applied Knowledge and Business and Corporate Law (UK variant)

- Can be taken at any time
- Automarked questions
- Results issued immediately after exam

Session CBEs The rest of the Applied Skills and Strategic Professional Exams (except Advanced TAX IRL)

- Available during the March, June, September and December exam weeks.
- Applied Skills are a mix of automarked and expert marked questions. Strategic Professional are 100% Constructive response.
- Results issued at same time as paper-based results – approximately 6 weeks later

- This award is benchmarked at the first year of a UK University degree programme, an HND or equivalent.

- Depending on when students take their exams and complete the Foundations in Professionalism module, the ACCA Diploma in Accounting and Business could be achieved in 6-12 months.



Practical Experience Requirement

PER Practical experience | ACCA Global



- To complete PER you'll need to achieve 36 months of supervised experience in a relevant accounting or finance role and complete nine performance objectives (all five Essentials and four Technical objectives).
- Many types of experience count towards your PER. Work completed before registering for the ACCA can also count provided your previous supervisor will sign-off your achievements from that time. – you don't have to achieve 36 months with the same employer
 - Before, during or after you sit your ACCA exams
 - Any industry, sector or country
 - Part-time, temporary or voluntary work
 - Work before registering with ACCA as a student.
 - Internships and volunteering



PER – Approved employer

- However, if you join an ACCA approved employer with training development approval at Gold or Platinum level then you can potentially claim performance objective exemption. In that case, you must still complete 36-months of experience before you become an ACCA member.
